### Out of Bounds to the Children - Grounds and Equipment rules

Both clubs operate within the confines of the school premises and there are certain areas which are out of bounds for children – whilst they are in our care. These are as discussed, together with the rules, with the children on a regular basis ie at the start/during most weeks term time and also each day during the holidays.

#### Rules include as follows;-

- Do not enter the Kitchen areas at any time.
- Only Playleaders to go in the sheds
- Never go behind the curtains in the hall or use the school equipment that is in the hall.
- Classrooms once school has finished nobody should return to the classrooms.
- Car park danger do not venture into the car park without an adult or under the guidance of a Playleader.
- Do not go behind the wall on the top playground or play on the top grass area (Morgans)
- Do not play on the play equipment without playleader supervision
- Do not go beyond the Annex (infant school playground).
- Do not go out of the gate in the playground (behind club building) at Abel Smith.

#### **GROUNDS AND EQUIPMENT**

Staff are responsible for ensuring that;

- ➤ Children respect school grounds and all equipment
- ➤ Children respect the boundaries and out of bounds rules
- > Children do not enter the sheds at any time
- ➤ Children are encouraged to put games and equipment away, ensuring all pieces are enclosed, this applies to indoor and outdoor equipment.

## Playleaders should

- ➤ Give out equipment from the shed and encourage children to return equipment to the area in front of the shed
- ➤ Return shed keys to the Senior Playleaders
- Ensure floors are swept after meal times and at the end of each day
- Ensure that the children respect The Dell and others equipment ie Playgroup.
- Ensure children are safely adhering to the procedures.

It is everybody's responsibility to check that The Dell is clean and tidy ready for tomorrow's activities.
